We had a massively successful fall kickball event with 14 teams and over \$11k raised! Save Property Management, specializing in low-income housing for people experiencing homelessness and a qualifying disability, goes the extra mile to create community. Recently we celebrated a Thanksgiving Dinner, a resident birthday party, and we look forward to a Holiday celebration where we expect over 200 people to attend. Our Silverleaf staff work with over 1200 people annually to find and maintain offsite housing. They stay busy as we are the largest non-governmental agency serving people who are eligible for Tenant Based Rental Assistance. We also serve the community with Emergency Assistance funds.
