



Eli is a young veteran with active psychosis who had been sleeping in a park. Unable to access his VA benefits in his condition, Eli needed help and was having a hard time finding it.

That's when he found our flier at the library that led him to SAVE, Inc. In just 16 months, Eli was able to turn his life around. With supportive case managers, he was able to access his VA funds, pay off his past debts, buy a car, and find permanent housing in an apartment!

## SAVE, INC. BREAKS GROUND ON NEW HOUSING PROJECT

Forty future homes for Kansas City's most vulnerable citizens became one step closer to a reality with the groundbreaking of Bodhi, the latest joint project of SAVE, Inc. and The Vecino Group.



The development is located at 39th and Jackson. Bodhi has been over 3 years in the making, and will include townhome-style residences in a supportive community for individuals with persistent and severe mental illness.

"Bodhi marks a significant milestone for the near 40-year history of SAVE, Inc.," says Patrick McLaughlin, CEO of SAVE, Inc. "It shows the continued efforts of our organization to care for the most basic of human rights - housing - and to do so with a human-centered approach." Bodhi marks the second joint venture with The Vecino Group, following the 2021 opening of Alhaven, a 50-unit complex located on SAVE, Inc.'s main campus at 31st and Harrison. SAVE, Inc. plans to open Bodhi in spring 2026. The groundbreaking ceremony was attended by Kansas City, Missouri Mayor Quinton Lucas, and other local leaders.
